CDSCO ASKED TO ACT ON 24 SUSPECTED DRUGS

The Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC), which is the National Coordination Centre for the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI), has recommended to the CDSCO for regulatory actions against 24 drugs which have been found to show adverse drug reactions (ADRs).

According to sources, the India specific drug safety signals, drug alerts and others have been identified from the reported ADRs by the Signal Review Panel (SRP) of the PvPI and has recommended to the CDSCO for the appropriate regulatory actions against the list of 24 suspected drugs.

Among these drugs, Carbamazepine shows the ADR of Stevens Johnson syndrome (SJS) and Toxic Epidrml Necrolysis (TEN). The PvPI has recommended to the CDSCO for drug safety label change - patient may be screened for HLAB 1502 prior to initiating the carbamazepine treatment. On this recommendation, the CDSCO has issued an order to all MAHs to comply the same. Mannitol is showing the ADR of Hypokalaemia, and the PvPI has recommended to include in Prescribing Information which is in process now.

Piperacillin and Tazobactam have shown the ADR of Hypokalaemia, Bronchospasm and the PvPI has recommended to the CDSCO to include in Prescribing Information. The CDSCO has issued an order to all MAHs to comply the same.

Azithromycin, Cefixime and Cloxacillin have shown ADR of Acute Generalised Exanthematosus Pustulosis and PvPI has recommended to the CDSCO to include in

Prescribing Information which is in process now.

NPPA FAILS TO FIX PRICES OF CORONARY STENTS DUE TO INSUFFICIENT DATA

The National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA), which has initiated the exercise of determination of ceiling price of coronary stents, is literally struggling to fix the ceiling prices of coronary stents as it could not compile sufficient data from the market for fixing the prices.

Following a notification issued by the Department of Pharmaceuticals (DoP) bringing coronary stents as part of Schedule-I of DPCO, 2013 vide S.O.4100(E) dated 21/12/2016, the National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority has initiated the process of determination of ceiling price of coronary stents. "Unlike other scheduled drugs, the market data of PTR is not being captured by AIOCD (Pharmatrac) because of the different nature of trade channels in case of coronary stents where hospitals/nursing homes are acting as de-facto 'Retailers'. In the given scenario, National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority is compiling price related relevant verifiable data form different sources and not in a position, as of now, to calculate and upload draft 'provisional price' as per DoP letter no. 31015/44/2016-PLI dated 11/07/2016", the NPPA clarified in an office memorandum.

However, in spite of these limitations, in the interest of widest stakeholder' consultation, the NPPA has prepared a list of options of price control which is likely to be put up to Authority which, however, may consider any other option within the ambit of DPCO, 2013.

The options prepared by the NPPA include Average of Price to Distribution (PTD)/Price to Stockiest (PTS) + 16 percent Retailer Margin, if applicable' CGHS prices+ 10 percent Increase per annum as applicable in case of nonscheduled drugs under para 20; Cost of Production (CoP) + 35 percent Trade Margin for Domestic manufactured Stents as suggested by Sub-Committee report on Trade Margin; Landed Cost (LC) + 35 percent Trade Margin for Imported Stents as suggested by Sub-Committee report on Trade Margin; Average of (CGHS + PTD/PTS) + 16 percent Retailer Margin, if applicable; and any other Methodology suggested by stakeholders.

The National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority has invited stakeholders to make representation with authenticated data/information within 10 working days to NPPA in order to take necessary action in the matter.
